The annual tri-school pre-season meet was considered one of the feature attractions of the SD track season.

96 years ago in 1921, the first Grossmont High School's Boys Track Team took the field. The Girls Track Team did not begin until 1977 as the impact of Title IX made itself felt on campus with the increasing number of girls teams.

During nearly 10 decades, the Boys Track Teams have won a total of 24 League Championships. For 23 years, from 1924-1955, Jack Mashin coached the Foothillers to a 145-37 record, equivalent to an 80% win record, winning 9 league titles. From 1957-1968, for 12 seasons, Marlin Baer was the head track coach with a win loss record of 250 to 43, including 5 Varsity (A) championships, 9 Class B crowns, and 11 straight C titles, with a string of 66 straight C league wins.

In 1962, Foothiller Brad Baer in the Shot Put with a throw of 59'3/8" and Ed Speed in the Discus with a throw of 152'1" were named to the C.I.F. All San Diego Section Track and Field Team. One of our outstanding girl athletes is Darcy Arreola, 1984 CIF 880 champion, 1986 CIF 1600 Meter Champion,1986 CIF Track Player of the Year, and 1986 California State 1600 Meter Champion.

Today's coaches are committed to improving both the competitive spirit of the athletes as well as the facilities. Head Coach John Mozerka states, "Thank you to all the student-athletes that made the 2017 Grossmont Track and Field Team such a success. Your hard work and dedication have paid off!" The Boys Team is hoping to add 2017 to the 24 League Championships this year.
